SERMON NOTES THE PARADOX OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 4:7-18 • Speaker: Dr Violet James

Introduction

Many Christians do not believe that suffering is part of the Christian life. If a Christian suffers sickness, or is stricken by adversities, it is because he or she must have sinned against God and is being punished by Him! Paul explains to us in 2 Corinthians 4:7-18 that suffering is God's way of growing us. In fact, without suffering there will be no glory and without suffering there can be no growth. In order to help us grasp this truth, Paul uses a literary term called paradox, to convey this powerful truth.

A paradox is an apparent contradiction. If we were to take the words apart, they will become opposites. But when we bring them together, one idea flows into the other and adds richness to the words by magnifying the truth.

A. Ordinary Yet Extraordinary (4:7)

- 1. Paul was ordinary like a jar of clay.
- 2. Paul had a 'treasure' that made him extraordinary

B. Weak Yet Strong (4:8-15)

- 1. Paul used paradoxes to describe his testimony (verses 8-9)
- 2. Paul used paradoxes to explain Jesus in him (verses 10-12)

C. Decaying Yet Renewing (4:16-18)

- 1. 'Slight' and 'momentary' in comparison to 'weight(y)' and 'eternal' gains
- 2. Focus is on the 'unseen' and 'eternal', not the 'seen' and 'transient'
