Topic: Critical Social Justice and the Bible

This talk examines the ideology behind the contemporary critical justice movement. It shows that the inspiration behind this movement's understanding of justice is not the Bible or the biblical worldview but social Marxism, postmodernism and critical theory.

The talk will contrast this modern secular understanding of justice with the biblical concept.

Critical social justice has very little to do with justice, as it is traditionally understood. Critical social justice is nourished by a toxic ideology which in fact perpetuates injustice, and leads to the destructive polarisation of society.

About the Speaker

Dr Roland Chia is Chew Hock Hin Professor of Christian Doctrine at Trinity Theological College and Theological and Research Advisor at the Ethos Institute for Public Christianity (https://ethosinstitute.sg/).

2024-2026 DEACONS ELECTION

- 2024 Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Election of Deacons 2024-2026 (two-year term) will be held on 22 September 2024 (Sunday). The deacon board has decided to conduct the AGM onsite and details will be given later. Please be reminded that participation at AGM and Election of Deacons is a membership obligation.
- According to the Church Constitution, there shall be no more than 15 deacons in the
 Deacon Board. The number of nominees for the coming Election shall be at least 11 in
 total and 8 deacons shall be elected. Together with the 6 deacons of the current term,
 there will be a total of 14 members in the new Deacon Board 2024/2025. A deacon's term
 of office shall be two years and he/she shall be eligible for re-election for a maximum of
 one consecutive term, except for the office of Treasurer.
- Out of the 14 deacons in the current board, the term of 8 deacons (Ng Wee Hua Sean, Tse Man Hei, Mui Chee Yin Casey, Law Cham Leung Alex, Lui Chi Pang, Ng Sheng Tong Mervin, Lin Yin Peng, Kong Wai Meng Javier) would be up. Ng Wee Hua Sean, Tse Man Hei and Mui Chee Yin Casey are due for sabbatical and cannot stand for re-election, while the rest are eligible. The remaining 6 deacons (Mak Sum Shing Andrew, Young Tak Yue Taky, Leung Ka Hin, Cheok Ru Sern, Chong Fui Kim, Koh Kin Teng) need not stand for election this year.
- As per last year, the incumbent pastors and deacons plus members will concurrently make their nominations of candidates. Members who wish to make nominations may obtain the "Nomination Form for Election of Deacons" by downloading it from our Church "Mobile App".
- Members who wish to table item(s) for discussion during the AGM should write in to the
 Deacon Board before or on 11 August 2024 (Sunday) through Deacon Board Secretary via
 his email address (Javierkong.gscc@gmail.com), which will deliberate on the suggested
 items and where suitable, will include the item(s) in the AGM Agenda. The person tabling
 the item(s) has to be present on the day of AGM to participate in the discussion.
- The nomination has started from 07 July 2024. The completed nomination forms and
 proposed item(s) should reach Deacon Board Secretary via his email address
 (Javierkong.gscc@gmail.com) before or on 11 August 2024 (Sunday). The Deacon Board
 shall deliberate on all the nominees in the CLC meeting on 17 August 2024. Please uphold
 the preparation of AGM and Election of Deacons in prayer.
