Introduction

Rev. Dr. Joseph Hiow Family Ministry Pastor



When I was in secondary school, I started pondering about what life was all about. As a young boy, I always believed that life is wonderful, precious, yet mysterious and incomprehensible. Though I had many questions concerning life, I had no answers to all of them. For instance, "Who am I?" "Why am I in this world?" The more I tried to find all these answers, the more I would get into frustration, anxiety, and restlessness as a result. Hence, I avoided asking.

Then in secondary 4, a good friend introduced me to a pastor of a church in hometown, Kulai, Johor. The pastor encouraged me to join his church. I still remember, there

was a short term mission team from Singapore holding an evangelistic rally, entitled, "Sheep That Are Not Of This Sheep Pen." (John 10: 16) I was touched by God's love and was so excited to know that God loves me so much that He died for me, a sinner, at the cross. During the altar call, I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Lord and Savior.

In 1993, I joined a 3-month discipleship training course by a few Chinese Presbyterian churches in Johor. At that time, God affirmed His calling in my life by building up my faith in Him and His Word. I remember the message through Rev Liu Bi Chai on Matthew 9: 35-38, "...The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field." I was really moved by the message, and committed myself for God's mission and His kingdom as a pastor and Bible teacher. In 1996, with the affirmation and encouragement from my church pastor and leaders, I enrolled for my theological training at Singapore Bible College. I then embarked on my journey serving as a pastor in Malaysia and Singapore up to today.

I am married to Tirtawati Wijaya (Christine) and we have four lovely children aged from 12 to 17 years old.
