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2026 AGM AND 2026-2028 DEACONS ELECTION

- The 2026 Annual General Meeting (AGM) and the 2026-2028 Election of Deacons (two-year term) will be held on 27 September 2026 (Sunday). The AGM will be conducted onsite, and further details will be given at a later date. Please be reminded that participation in the AGM and Election of Deacons is a membership obligation.
- According to the Church Constitution, there shall be no more than 15 deacons in the Deacon Board. There will be a total of 15 members in the new Deacon Board 2026/2027. A deacon's term of office shall be two years and he/she shall be eligible for re-election for a maximum of one consecutive term, except for the office of Treasurer.
- The current Deacon Board comprises 15 members. Of these, 9 deacons (Kong Wai Meng Javier, Chu Ming Cheung Eric, Chu Hiu Wen Wendy, Poon Pui Him Henry, Tse Man Yiu, Lin Yin Peng, Wong Yan Seng, Tsui Chin Hin Ronald, Chui Kuk Sun Sunny) will be concluding their two-year term, while the remaining 6 deacons (Mak Sum Shing Andrew, Young Tak Yue Taky, Law Cham Leung Alex, Cheok Ru-Sern, Ng Wee Hua Sean, Koh Kin Teng) will continue into the second year of their term of office.
- Pastors, deacons, and members will concurrently submit their nominations for candidates. Members who wish to nominate candidates may obtain the 'Nomination Form for Election of Deacons' by downloading it from the Church website.
- The nomination has started from 5 July 2026. The completed nomination forms should reach the Deacon Board Secretary via email (db.secretary@gsgccc.org.sg) no later than 23 August 2026 (Sunday). The Deacon Board will deliberate on all the

nominees in the CLC meeting on 29 August 2026. Please uphold the preparation of AGM and Election of Deacons in prayer.

- Members who wish to table item(s) for discussion at the AGM should write in to the Deacon Board no later than 23 August 2026 (Sunday) through the Deacon Board Secretary, Dn Tse Man Yiu, via email (db.secretary@gsgccc.org.sg). The Deacon Board will deliberate on the suggested items and where suitable, will include the item(s) in the AGM Agenda. The person tabling the item(s) has to be present on the day of AGM to participate in the discussion.
