NEPAL FLOOD RELIEF

On 26 August, a torrent of water, mud, and debris swept away entire communities in Nepal, killing over a thousand people and leaving thousands missing. Our mission partners, Mr & Mrs Sheng from SIM, together with the local Christian relief volunteers are responding to the crisis. They plan to establish simple but sturdy corrugated-metal temporary Christian relief stations in the disaster-affected areas. Each station will serve four key functions: 1) Reception and Temporary Shelter; 2) Relief Supplies Distribution Hub; 3) Trauma and Psychological Counselling Centre; and 4) Worship and Fellowship Centre. To support their relief efforts, our church Love & Care Ministry will offer a S\$3,000 donation. Please keep our mission partners and the affected communities in your prayers.

Scripture: Acts 7:17-34 • Speaker: Dr Roland Chia

Reflection Questions:

1. Can you recall a time when your circumstances seemed to go from bad to worse, and you questioned what God was doing? How does the sermon's reminder that "God's hiddenness is not his absence" speak to that experience?
2. Have you ever felt rejected or misunderstood in a role or calling you believed God gave you? How does the example of Moses—and David Brainerd—challenge or encourage you to remain faithful even without immediate success?
3. Where in your daily routine—your work, home life, or quiet moments—might God be inviting you to recognize "holy ground"? What would it look like for you to trust that God is at work in the mundane, unseen places of your life?

2026 Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Election of Deacons 2026-2028

1. Members should have received the second notice of AGM 2026, either by email (for those with a registered address with the church) or by postal mail (for those without). Included with the notice are the Annual Report, Election Form, and two AGM papers. Members are encouraged to take time to review all included information. If you have not received it, please contact the Deacon Board Secretary, Dn Tse Man Yiu, via email at db.secretary@gsgccc.org.sg or the Church office at 6337 7144.
2. **2026 Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Election of Deacons 2026-2028 (two-year term)** will be held on **27 September 2026 (Sunday) at 11:15am** in the Sanctuary. Members are encouraged to make your best effort to attend the AGM and participate in the Election of Deacons as part of your spiritual commitment and membership responsibilities. If you are unable to attend the AGM due to health reasons, overseas travel, or other valid reasons, please notify the Deacon Board by completing the “Notification of Absence at Annual General Meeting” form. **The form can be filled online or you may also get a physical copy from the Church office.**
3. According to the Church Constitution, there should be no more than 15 deacons in the Deacon Board. The number of nominees for the coming Election is 11, of which 8 will be elected. Together with the 6 deacons of the current term, there will be a total of 14 members in the new Deacon Board 2026/2027. A deacon’s term of office shall be two years.
